

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. **ENTRIES** on this form, which must be accompanied by entrance Fees, to be in the hands of the Tournament Co-ordinator, P.O. Box 71, Korumburra, by no later than Sunday 24th November 2019.
- 2. **ENTRIES** are restricted to Amateurs who are members of clubs of Golf Victoria, or of Golf Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by Golf Australia. The committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 3. **HANDICAPS** All entrants must be able to provide evidence of their current GA handicap either by Golflink ID or other Club Authorisation.
- 4. **COMPETITION** shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the links over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the committee in charge of the competition, except when the committee is in doubt, it shall reserve the right to refer the dispute to Golf Victoria.
- 5. **THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE** shall have the entire management of the tournament.
- 6. **ANY PROTEST** must be lodged, in writing, at the Club House before 6:00 p.m. on the day on which the dispute arises.
- 7. **THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE**, or such person as they may authorise, shall have the following powers:
 - a. Temporarily alter a player's Australian Handicap in accordance with 'the player', or the USGA Course rating and Handicapping System;
 - b. To vary the handicap limits in events played in more than one grade;
 - c. To permit any competitor who is not ready to start at his appointed time to start at a later time;
 - d. To alter or vary the conditions (except 2 & 3) should they deem it advisable;
 - e. To shorten any contest or fix another day;
 - f. To limit the number of entries in any event and alter the time of starting an event;
 - g. To Cancel any event if insufficient entries

8. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE

- a. Scratch Event Winner will be decided by a play-off over holes to be nominated by the Tournament Committee or as otherwise decided by the Tournament Committee.
- b. Handicap Event The winner will be decided by a count back as recommended by Golf Australia.
- 9. NO PLAYER may be awarded more than one trophy on any one day, excluding NTP's.
- 10. **POST ENTRIES** will be accepted subject to field capacity.
